1. HEALTH / SOCIAL issues or anything that is preventing you from full participation in choir rehearsals and activities.

At a course:

- Talk to Student Welfare Manager, Emma Blood-Mouat or NZSSC Manager, Ange Kalogeropoulos. This can be in private, or over a hot chocolate during morning tea - whatever is best for you. Or talk privately with any staff member you feel most comfortable with: Sue, Brent or Ben.
- Talk to your section Tātāriki (pastoral care leaders) they can talk to Ange or Emma on your behalf if you find this difficult.
- Talk to your Choir Leaders.
- NOTE: If you find things hard to talk about, you might want to bring a friend or put your thoughts in writing.
